Hi everyone, I hope you are all keeping well. This week marks the start of Autumn, and we had a real misty morning when I looked out today! Harvest is on the way, so please consider what you could donate to the food bank in the way of tinned and packaged goods. I am happy to report that another frog has been seen in the pond, although I haven't spotted it myself yet, Annie assures me she saw it, so I will try and get a picture when it appears again.

My week of eating the same rations as a Syrian refugee as now ended, and I managed to stick it out to the end, thank you for your sponsorship, I raised **£600.60** for the Concern worldwide Uk charity. Naomi and I raised over **£1400** between us, enough to feed **8 refugees for a year** and provide **a two-week training** course for a woman to start her own business so she can provide for her family, and to fund **4 visits to a medical centre** to access life-saving treatment. WOW, thank you! Below you can see pictures of the food I chose for my first breakfast after the challenge, I was really missing fruit! Also, a picture of the rations I had over, just a day and bit rations of rice and a little oil.
