Let's talk about our Bible verses;

I've been planting some seeds over the last month and some of them are already sprouting up through the soil. Let me show you:

In our bible passage, Jesus talks about planting a kernel, which is the same as a seed. He says if you don't plant the seed, and put it under the ground, it will remain alone. So, if I hadn't planted my seed, it would have stayed the same, just one seed, doing nothing useful. But now I have planted it, the seed 'dies' by being under the ground, but comes back to life when the plant grows from it. As the plant grows it will produce more seed and therefore is no longer on its own, there are many seeds!

Jesus knew in order to fulfil his purpose, that he had to die on the cross. Thinking of that makes us sad, but Jesus needed to complete his mission in order for God's plan for everyone to take place. Just as the seed has to go under the ground, before it can grow and produce many seeds, so Jesus had to die so that he could come back to life and start the disciples on their journey to tell many, many, people the good news and bring glory to God.
