

Children and family talk for 26th September 2021

Hello everyone, its lovely to have you with me as we look at more of the bible and worship God together. Let's begin by reading from the bible, Psalm 19 verse 10 from the Message:

God's word is better than a diamond,
Better than a diamond set between emeralds.
You'll like it better than strawberries in spring,
Better than red, ripe strawberries.

Do you like strawberries? I do! Today we are looking at living the best life we can. But that doesn't mean we get to eat strawberries all the time, let's read about how Jesus explained this to his special friends, the disciples.

Today we are reading excerpts from

Mark 9. verses 38 to 50. This follows last week's reading where Jesus had to tell the disciples off for arguing about who was the greatest. Jesus continues to teach his disciples and talk with them.

'John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone using your name to cast out demons, but we told him to stop because he wasn't in our group."

"Don't stop him!" Jesus said, "No one who performs a miracle in my name will quickly turn against me. Anyone who is not against us is for us. If anyone gives you even a cup of water because you belong to the Messiah, I tell you the truth, that person will surely be rewarded. But if someone should encourage others to do wrong things, they will have their punishment, it would be better for them if they were to put a millstone around their neck and be thrown into the sea.

Jesus wanted them to do the right things, not be tempted to do wrong things or be confused or influenced by the wrong people. He gave them an example to help then, he said: good salt is worthless if it loses its saltiness; it can't season anything. So don't lose your flavour! Live in peace with each other. '
