
# Children and families talk for Sunday 29th January 2023

Hello everyone!

Thanks for joining me today to look at another bible passage together. Todays bible reading is a very well known one, and is part of what we sometimes call; 'The sermon on the mount', as it was when Jesus went up on a mountainside to speak to and teach the people who were following him. It has another title too, 'the Beatitudes'.

#### Matthew 5: 1-12.



Let's talk about our bible reading:

Buttons: Hey!

Sandy: Hey! Are you feeling blessed today?

B: Ummm, what does it mean?

S: Well, it means, feeling happy and content with what you have, God gives us blessings, they are all the good things.

B: Well, ... let me think.

S: Well, are you happy?

B: I was until you started asking me difficult questions.

S: Oh, sorry.

B: How about you? Are you feeling blessed?

S: Yes! I have you as a friend, and God looking after me.

B: Wow, that's great! But why does it say we will be blessed when bad things happen, like when people are unkind? I don't think that's very good.

S: Well, Jesus wanted us to know that even when bad things happen, that we can feel ok about it, because things will turn out ok in the end. If we are Jesus' followers, we have a special place in God's kingdom, a big reward in heaven.

B: Okay, but I still think its not ok to be unkind.

S: Of course it's not okay to be unkind, and we know that, which is why you'll always be my friend and Jesus' friend too, Buttons. There may be good and bad times ahead, but we'll always have our faith in God to help us through, knowing that there are blessings from God to come.

Let's talk to God now:

### This is me – praising you.

(arms above head, waving from side to side)

#### This is me – thanking you.

(place hands together in prayer position)

#### This is me – loving you.

(hands crossed across chest hugging yourself) Through good and bad, when happy or sad, thank you, Lord, for being there, thank you, Lord, you always care. Amen.

# And let's say the grace together:

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ,

The love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit,

Be with us all, now and forever more,

Amen.
