Talk:

We have learnt that it's not good to worry, and much better to do something helpful, just as Nehemiah did in our story today. I hope you will be taking away something from this service today. Is there something more you can do to help with the climate crisis, or to make this a better world for everything that lives on it?

Take the stone in your hands and feel it. Get to know it...but do not own it. It doesn't belong to you. It has a life of its own. It cries out to God with its own voice.

It doesn't belong to you. Of course it doesn't. You don't have to own everything. This stone has a work of its own to do. And so do you. But take this stone with you, and care for it as if were the whole world – which it is.

Be yourself. And if what this means is unclear to you, look around at the things of this earth. Study the stone which always does what it was made to do: it doesn't always fall in the same way, sometimes resting in high places and at other times finding its rest where the earth allows it to lie, but its purpose is to move downward, and in this, the stone loves God in the way it can, singing the new song which God gives each creature and thing – and also you who hear this and at times wonder what to do, and how to be.
