What's in a name? Why do we have a name? If we didn't, could have a conversation like, 'you know, that well-known, fair-haired, elegant lady, always ready to chat to people'. 'who, The Queen?.' 'No, lady in our church! You know. The one that organises the church meals!.' Of course, we know her as Janine!! So, we all have a name, and God knows each one of us by our name too.

All names have a meaning, e.g.

David - beloved, favourite

Janine - God is gracious.

Elizabeth - God's promise

Richard - mighty ruler

Does anyone know the meaning of your name?

(Kids uncover initials of JESUS) ... whose name is this? Does anyone know the meaning of His name?

It's a form of the Hebrew name Yeshua and means 'The Lord is Salvation;' 'The Lord saves'; rescuer; deliverer; saviour.

Going to look at some ways to describe who Jesus is and what He does, using each letter of His name, so first one is 'J'.

Talk - 'J'

How can we describe Jesus that begins with the letter 'J'? He was a Jew yes, that starts with a 'J', but there's something else about Jesus that starts with a 'J'. There's a clue in the story of Jesus birth. PPT pic 1 When an angel came to tell Mary and Joseph about their baby boy the angel said, (Luke 2: 10), 'Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people.' Jesus told us so much about God and His love for us, about how to best live our lives, and so many wonderful things. And near the end of His time with His disciples He told them PPT pic 2 (John 17: 13), 'I say these things (to you) so that (you) may have the full measure of My joy within (you).'

Joy. (UNCOVER JOY)

Joy isn't just being happy, but it's also a deep down, warm, content, peaceful loveliness, Joy.

Joy is an amazing word. When somebody asked Jesus what was the most important command of all, (a command is something God has told us to do), Jesus said, PPT pic 3 (Luke 10: 27), "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind'; and, 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'" That's the whole of our Christian faith in a sentence, and it's all wrapped up in JOY, PPT pic 4 putting Jesus first, Others second, Yourself last .. J .. O .. Y. (uncover, left of curtain).

Let's sing, with joyful voices, about joy!

Talk - 'E'

Next letter, E. There's a verse in the bible book of Hebrews that says something very interesting about Jesus. Hebrews 13: 8, 'Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.' (put up crossword right of centre).

How long is 'forever', when does 'forever' stop/end? NEVER!!
Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever, that's every day, always.
Now, we are all different aren't we?! Some people we immediately think of as friendly, some as organised, some as fun, some caring, some as very thoughtful.
What's the first thing about Jesus that comes to your mind when you hear the name 'Jesus', which parts of His character? When I think of Jesus the same forever, I think of gently smiling face, soft eyes deeply loving, arms outstretched to hold me ... and He'll be like that forever, and another word for forever is Eternal, because Jesus is 'E', Eternal. (UNCOVER ETERNAL).

So, Jesus is **J**oy and He is **E**ternal. Let's sing about that now,

Next letter is 'S'. **Secure** (UNCOVER SECURE)

Crossword on stand, with SECURE already uncovered.

Secure, lots of words that mean secure.

If you are in a busy Highstreet, how does the person you are with keep you from getting lost or separated from them? Hold your hand.

We are **held tight** (UNCOVER HELD TIGHT) in Jesus' hands because we are so precious to Him, He wants to keep us close to Him and His love.

If a butterfly gets stuck indoors and you want to take it somewhere better for it, how do you do that? Keep it in your closed hands.

Bible tells we are **kept** (UNCOVER KEPT) like that in Jesus' prayers before Father God. How about that?! We pray to Jesus, and He prays for us before God too. We are kept in His prayers.

Lots of places in Psalms where the great King David was having a really rough time, all sorts of things going wrong, people being really nasty to him, doing bad things — ever had times like that, when you feel anxious, or afraid, or really down? What did David do? All over Psalms King David tells us that he ran to the Lord in his prayers, knowing that God (and Jesus for us) was his refuge, his strong fortress, his **safe** (UNCOVER SAFE) place, that God would keep him safe through all his problems.

There's a verse in the book of Romans (8: 38) in the bible where the apostle Paul says this, **PPT pic 5** 'For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.'

Paul says he is convinced, he is **certain** (UNCOVER CERTAIN), that nothing can separate us from the love of God in Jesus, we are **fixed** (UNCOVER FIXED) and **Secure** in His loving care for us.

S is for **S**ecure.

Jesus has also Secured (UNCOVER D) something, but we'll look at that after our next song, which talks about us being safe and secure in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Another letter 'S'. So far we know that Jesus is **J**oy **E**ternal, and He has **S**ecured something beginning with 'S'. Hmmm. What could that be?

Acts 4: 12 tells us what that is, **PPT pic 6** 'Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.'

(UNCOVER SALVATION)

The Name of Jesus.

Jesus has Secured Salvation – total forgiveness for all wrongs and sins, and there's no one else who can do that but Jesus. Who is this Salvation for? (UNCOVER US)

J E S U S – He is Joy Eternal, He has Secured Us Salvation ... that's our JESUS!! He wants His Joy to be in us too;

He is the same beautiful, powerful, ever-present helper and friend forever, **E**ternally;

we are **S**ecure in His loving care; nothing can separate us from that; and He has secured **U**s **S**alvation, offering us complete forgiveness and new life with Him.
